## Over 355 Attend Catholics at the Capitol

Catholics from around the state gathered at the Monona Terrace Community and Convention Center on March 31, 2009, for the 5<sup>th</sup> biennial Catholic legislative day. Participants attended educational workshops, honed advocacy skills, and met with legislators to discuss issues of public policy concern. Advocacy materials, such as WCC issue briefs, 2009 Public Policy Positions, and legislative directory, will soon be made available on the Catholics at the Capitol 2009 page of the WCC website.

## WCC Testimony to Joint Finance Committee on Budget

In a <u>memo</u> to the Joint Finance Committee, WCC expressed its support and its opposition to a number of the Governor's budget provisions. The WCC has also prepared an <u>issue brief</u> on the budget to inform Catholics about provisions related to the poor and the vulnerable.
