CATHOLIC CONFERENCE ADDS SPANISH TRANSLATIONS TO WEBSITE

The Wisconsin Catholic Conference is adding Spanish language versions of several key documents to its website. Previously, all WCC documents have appeared only in English.

"It's past the time for us to be doing this," WCC Executive Director John Huebscher noted. "We want to be more inclusive in the way our materials are prepared and distributed to Catholics and others in Wisconsin."

The items that are now in Spanish include the two pastoral letters by the bishops related to the fall referenda. One urges support for the constitutional amendment to define marriage and the other urges opposition to the advisory referendum on the death penalty. The WCC's Guidelines on Church Involvement in Electoral Politics also appears in Spanish.

Huebscher added that the WCC plans to provide Spanish language versions of more materials in the future.
