HUNDREDS GATHER IN MADISON FROM AROUND THE STATE TO SUPPORT LIFE DURING 2026 MARCH FOR LIFE WISCONSIN

Hundreds gathered at the Wisconsin State Capitol in support of life at the annual March for Life Wisconsin on Saturday, April 25.

Individuals from across the state heard from Wisconsin-based pro-life speakers who shared their expertise on the importance of protecting life from conception to natural death. Speakers included Bishop Schuerman from the Archdiocese of Milwaukee, Laura Karlen, Sara Patterson, Alison Schlei, Dr. Beth Anderson, Dr. Michael Kloess, Dr. Tara Sander Lee, and Lucas Vebber.

Bishop Schuerman emphasized that the love of God is the foundation of human dignity. In his remarks, he shared, “We are called to create a culture that witnesses to human dignity, and we witness most effectively when we live a life of charity. God’s love for us is the true source of our dignity, our identity, and our worth. God’s love will never change, and nothing can reduce our dignity nor diminish our worth. We are called to build a culture of life. A culture of life is one that proclaims God’s love and plan for each person.”

After the speakers, participants joined in a joyful and peaceful march around the State Capitol. “We hope the March inspires everyone throughout the state to consider how they can step up and be pro-life for the whole life,” said Wisconsin Catholic Conference Associate Director Tia Izzia. “For example, you can pray for families facing challenging circumstances, donate your time or money to your local pregnancy resource center which helps families in need (find a center near you at [123givelifewisconsin.org](https://www.123givelifewisconsin.org)), join your local Walking with Moms in Need group or start a group, and support public policies that help children and families thrive.”
